ARTICLE II. ENHANCED 911 SERVICE***Sec. 12-19. Purpose.**

The purpose of this article is to promote the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the city by providing a telephone number through which citizens can obtain rapid, direct public safety aid with reduced response time, as provided for in G.S. ch. 62A.

Sec. 12-20. Enhanced 911 charge.

There is hereby imposed an enhanced 911 charge per month, as established from time to time, on each exchange access facility subscribed to by telephone subscribers whose exchange access lines are in the city limits.

Sec. 12-21. Administration.

The city is authorized to contract with the local telephone service supplier for the purpose of providing enhanced 911 service and for billing and collection of the enhanced 911 charges on behalf of the city under the terms and conditions set forth in G.S. ch. 62A.

Sec. 12-22. Emergency Telephone System Fund.

All enhanced 911 service charges collected by the local telephone service supplier, less the administration expenses allowed by G.S. 62A-6, shall be remitted to the city Finance Director and deposited in a separate, restricted fund known as the Emergency Telephone System Fund, which shall be managed in accordance with G.S. 62A-7 and 62A-8.
